Can someone hire a removalist/contactless removalist to move into their new house as current rental is going to expire?	People are allowed to relocate during the lockdown. Removalists are considered an essential worker and can move you.
Is the person who delivers the groceries required to wear gloves?	The person delivering groceries is not required to wear gloves. The person delivering the items at the doorstep should make no contact with the people in the home. The items should be left at the door.
Please confirm place of worship is also closed as part of the Lockdown.	<p>Places of worship are closed to the general public.</p> <p>Places of worship can stream an online service/ceremony, but they can only have <u>one faith leader</u> who is doing the ceremony/service and only <u>one technical support person</u> on site.</p>
Should drivers of the logistics fleet wear masks when delivering to doorsteps?	Masks are not required in outdoor settings. The person delivering the items at the doorstep should make no contact with the people in the home. The items should be left at the door.
